

Streetsboro's Integrated Preschool Program
Registration Information for Peer Role Models 2017-2018

Call office to register for Information and Screening Session on Friday, February 17th at 9:30 am or 1:30 pm Registration packets will be distributed at these sessions.
Registration packets should be turned into the office starting Monday, February 27th.

Streetsboro City Schools provides special education and public preschool programming for the families in the Streetsboro City School District. Children enrolled are taught using the AEPS curriculum which is aligned with the State of Ohio's pre-Kindergarten Content Standards.

Who attends Streetsboro's Preschool?

Preschooler with a Disability:

A child between the ages of three and five who demonstrate delays in one or more areas of development during the screening process. Areas of delay include communication, motor, social/emotional/behavior, adaptive, cognitive and visual/hearing impairments.

Peer Role Model:

A child between the ages of three and five who does NOT have special needs can apply to the program as a peer role model. Peer role models must be 3 years of age and demonstrate the following characteristics:

- Age-appropriate behavior
- Interacts well with other children
- Easily separates from parent
- Potty-trained
- Strong communication skills

If my child demonstrates these characteristics, how do I enroll him as a role model in the program?

Interested families need to call the Streetsboro Elementary office to schedule a screening time for Friday, February 17th at either 9:30 or 1:30. Our teachers will meet with the children in a preschool classroom and parents will meet with the principal. It is important that both parent and child attend the session. Registration packets will be distributed at the meeting.

What if we are not able to attend the Information and Screening Session?

Meeting with the child is important for our preschool team. We are limited to the number of role models we can place in each classroom. Students are screened using a play-based assessment and norm-referenced screening tool. Your child's attendance at the session is mandatory to be considered for our program.

When do students attend Preschool?

Times may change for 2017-2018 school year. Students attend preschool Monday – Thursday for 2 ½ hours each day.

Morning: 8:25- 11:15 Afternoon: 12:30 – 2:50

Is there transportation available for students?

We cannot guarantee bussing for all role model students. Specific transportation questions should be directed to Beth Kinder, Director of Transportation at: (330) 626-4909.

What is the next step in enrolling in the program?

Submit the registration packet to the office starting Monday, February 27th, 2017 beginning at 9am. As registration packets are turned in they will be numbered in the order in which they are received. We have limited availability for our peer role models. If spots are filled, we will keep registrations on file and students will be on a waiting list.
